- 4. <u>Pestilence</u>- noun: A pernicious, evil influence or agent
- 5. <u>Thronged</u>- adj: Filled with great numbers crowded together
- 6. <u>Steadfast</u>- adj: Fixed or unchanging; steady
- 7. <u>Scourge</u>- noun: A source of widespread dreadful affliction and devastation
- 8. Oracle- noun: An authoritative person who divines the future
- 9. <u>Purge</u>- verb: To free from impurities; purify
- 10. Atone- verb: To make amends, as for a sin or fault: *These crimes must be atoned for*
