

DIRECT AND INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

The I.O. always precedes the D.O. pronoun. Whether it is before the conjugated verb, attached to the infinitive or attached to the present participle.

*Se los voy a dar (a ella).

*Voy a dárselos (a ella).

*Estoy dándoselos (a ella).

The I.O. pronouns le and les change to se when they are followed by the D.O. pronouns lo, la, los, or las.

*Se los voy a dar (a ella).
