An indirect object is the noun which is indirectly affected by the action of the verb.

Answers the question: "The subject (use verb here) **TO WHOM?**"

Le voy a dar regalos (a ella). I am going to give gifts **TO WHOM?*

When an I.O. is present in a sentence, **always** use the pronoun. The phrase itself is what is optional.

****Le** voy a dar regalos (a ella).*

The I.O. pronoun is located immediately preceding the conjugated verb **OR** attached to an infinitive **OR** a present participle.

****Le** voy a dar regalos (a ella).*

Voy a darle** regalos (a ella).*

Estoy dándole** regalos (a ella).*
