TRIANGLE TRADE ACTIVITY

Objective: To identify the three continents involved in Triangle Trade as well as the goods that were exchanged from one continent to another.

Directions: Take a slice of bread and, using a plastic knife, cut out a large triangle. Place the triangle on the space provided below. Label each port continent according to the directions: 1=North America 2=Europe 3=Africa Use a different colored M&M to represent each port. Now outline the triangle with three sticks of licorice to emphasize that the triangular trade was dependent on the exchange of slaves and other goods.

Once you have these steps finished, have out a pen or pencil and be ready to label your triangle "map".
