 - <u>All</u> homework is REQURIED to be turned in. Late assignments will be given partial credit unless due to absence.

Evaluations/Grades:

Grades will be calculated on a total point basis (Points earned / Total points possible). The following is an approximation of the breakdown of grades.

- 2. Quizzes
 - Daily or every other day (15-25 points each)
- 3. Tests
 - -At the end of each unit (100 points each)
- 4. Extra Credit there will be several opportunities to earn extra credit points throughout the semester
