

TOP TEN PROJECTS (SENIOR HIGH LEVEL ONLY)

TASC recognizes the 10 most outstanding projects performed by local councils. Student councils may submit their best projects using the format outlined below. Submissions will be judged by a committee chaired by the TASC Parliamentarian school.

ENTRY RULES FOR COMPETITION

1. Entries must have the required coversheet provided in this manual (see attached).
2. The entry should follow the format below, not exceeding two 8.5x10 pages, typed, one side only in addition to the cover sheet.
NAME of project
PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES (What were you trying to accomplish with the project?)
BRIEF DESCRIPTION of the activities
DESCRIPTION OF INVOLVEMENT with:
 - a) student council members
 - b) other students
 - c) other organizations
 - d) faculty
 - e) community
3. The entry must be accompanied by a signed evaluation by a least one teacher, administrator, or other staff member, other than the student council advisor.
4. The entry may include up to five photographs. If photos are included, secure to separate sheet(s) and label. Photo page(s) will not be included in the two page limit.
5. Schools may submit only one Top Ten Project entry per year.
6. All entries should be mailed to the TASC office postmarked no later than February.
7. Additional attachments are NOT accepted.
8. **BONUS! 5 points. If attending the Annual Conference, schools submitting an entry in Top 10 Projects will be required to lead a presentation on the project at the Annual Conference. In addition to the project submission, schools must also submit a presentation proposal form** (see www.tasconline.org).

 4. Overall results and success from the standpoint of:
 - a) student body participation/reaction 0-10
 - b) faculty/community participation/reaction 0-10
 5. Consideration of the circumstances of the project as it relates to the size of the school and/or community. 0-10
 6. Evaluation(s) received 0-10
