** Please practice **ADDITION or SUBTRACTION** math flash cards/facts with your child at home. It is so important that they become fluent.

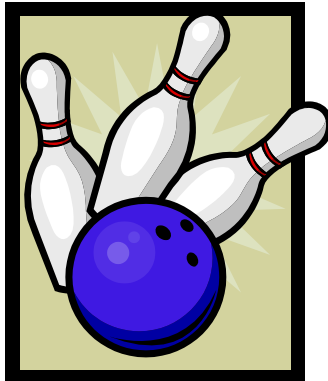
Handwriting: Handwriting matters on each and every page.
