



Homework in Highway 201

We hope to keep homework in Highway 201 to a minimum. Many days there will be no homework and much of the homework that is assigned will be relatively easy to complete. We are doing this because **we expect that students will give 100% during class time.** If it becomes apparent that students are not honoring class time by doing their very best during that time, then more regular and difficult homework will be assigned to make up for that loss.

All assignments and homework must be turned in

- 1) on the due date,
- 2) at the beginning of class (there'll be a box on the teacher's desk)
- 3) in hard copy form (no digital files, no email attachments). Any assignment turned in late, no matter the reason, will be penalized a letter grade for each day that it's late. That is, even an assignment that would receive an "A" will become an "F" if it is four days late. An assignment that is "C" work will become an "F" in a mere two days.

If a student is absent from class, then any assignment due that day must be turned in **on the next day the student is in school** (not the next class day). Assignments turned in on days other than Wednesday or Thursday should be placed in the teacher's mailbox (these are located near the front desk of the school, in front of Ms. Mason's office).

Highway 201 student will have four (4) "days of grace." A day of grace enables a student to turn in an assignment one day late (that is, the next school day, not the day of the next Highway class) without penalty. Only one day of grace may be used per assignment. **Days of grace may NOT be used for assignments that involve a presentation. Presentations of any kind must be done on the day assigned.**

Hence, it will be extremely important for students to keep up with their assignments and turn in them on time. As stated in the class syllabus, doing this is always the responsibility of the students themselves, especially when they miss a class. A failing grade on any assignment will trigger an email to the student's parents and Koinonia leader.

Your teachers will not "track you down" to ask for your un-turned-in assignments!
