

Vocabulary Study Ideas

- Start on Monday, and pick three or four words a day to focus on (your brain can only file away four words a day).
- Read over the sentences that the words are in.
- Talk to yourself about your word webs. Say things like, "Swift is kind of like fast or speedy, and it makes me think of cheetahs because they are fast. Slow is the opposite of swift."
- Try to make up a new sentence using each word.
- Let your parents know what your vocabulary words are and have them try to use one each day around you and see if you notice.
- Do your studying right before bed. Your brain will do a better job of putting what you learned into your memory folders.
