- You must put the date and have a salutation (i.e.: Dear Mrs. Manno)
- You must sign your letter!
- You must use formal, academic language, as well as proper grammar and punctuation.
- You must bring a hard copy and submit to turnitin.com or it will be graded according to the late policy
