

## **MISS SUTY'S SECOND GRADE BEHAVIOR POLICY**

Students are expected to follow school rules inside and outside of the classroom.

Our classroom rules are:

- Be kind to your classmates.
- Raise your hand and wait to be called on before speaking.
- Show respect for teachers, classmates and school property.
- Listen and respond to the FREEZE! Signal.

Positive behaviors are always emphasized and rewarded in our classroom. The students are rewarded when they are "caught doing something good" and when their table (group of desks) achieves 100 points for good behavior during the week. In each instance, the student is allowed to choose a prize from the treasure chest as a reward.

In the case of discipline, we use a behavior book in our classroom. The first time a student needs to write his/her name in the behavior book is considered a warning. This is a way to distract the student from any negative behavior and give them the chance to get back on track quickly. If the student signs the behavior book two times in one day, he/she will need to write a letter to his/her parents and sign it. This gives the student a chance to think about their action and decide what they need to do to get back on track again. If during the week your child was in the behavior book more than twice, I will notify you by email or phone call.
