Low Blood-Alcohol Level

1. Inhibition lowers.
2. Talkativeness increases.
3. Motor skills, all senses, and intelligence are dulled.
4. False confidence is instilled in the drinker.
5. Movement slows.
6. Memory becomes impaired,
7. Bursts of anger, aggression, crying, or excitement occur.
8. Ability to judge distances decreases.
9. Speech slurs.
10. Function of all sense organs is impaired.
11. Mood can shift suddenly.
12. Loss of control of body movements occurs.
