

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS



Dear Parents:

In order to help provide my students with an excellent educational climate, all students are expected to behave in an acceptable manner. I believe that success in life depends on self-discipline. In our classroom we will have a plan to encourage this.

RULES:

- 1. Follow directions, the first time they are given.
- 2. Raise your hand, and be called on, before speaking.
- 3. Stay in your seat and work on assignments during seatwork time.
- 4. Have your materials at your desk and be ready to work.
- 5. Have hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

For all of our actions there are reactions. For positive reactions (**rewards**) your child will receive praise, notes, free time and other extra privileges. Negative reactions (**consequences**) will occur in steps for individual students on a given day -

- 1. A verbal warning.
- 2. Last one in line.
- 3. Student completes a Behavior Response that needs to be signed by you and returned the next day to me.
- 4. Fifteen minutes in "time-out" area.
- 5. I'll contact you directly.
- ** A severe disruption would earn a visit to the principal's office.

Since we are a team working together to help your child achieve success, I would appreciate it if you would review this plan with your child. All members of our class benefit from a classroom ready to learn and do their best at all times!
