- The translations will also focus on **aspect** as regards the aorist tense, so make sure to review this element.
- You will also be asked to translate from the English to the Greek.

- You will be given a story (or two), taken from the workbook, and asked questions based on morphology, grammar, and culture. Be sure to review the workbook readings, paying special attention to the futures and aorist (especially taking care to notice **aspect**)
