

Español II: Requirements for Final Project – Use this as a check-off page.

If you are using this for the Around the World Day assignment, this will be due no later than Friday, April 13th

You must have:

- Title: ***Mi Diario de Viaje*** (on front page/cover)
- A **beginning paragraph** in the **past** (preterit) to introduce the travelogue. The travelogue itself will be in the present tense.
- 7 days, with at least one entry per day. Each entry will be at least three sentences.

Each entry describes (in the present tense):

- Where you went
- When you went
- What you did there
- What the weather was like
- A comment about what you thought of it **or** give a description of the place.
- Go with another person to a couple of places, so you're not alone every time you go.
- For each day, you must mention that you did one or both of the following:
 - Buy something
 - Eat something at a restaurant
- In all, there is a **minimum** of 21 sentences. (Feel free to write more than that.)
- **Provide illustrations to go with your text on each page.**

To start, choose a Spanish-speaking country (or region) where you could spend 3 (or more) days with something **different** to do and/or sites to visit each day.

You will probably find the most on the following places:

In addition to meeting above requirements, you will be graded on the following:

Grammar: (See attached rubric for how your writing will be graded)

- sentence structure
- adjective noun agreement in number and gender
- irregular and regular verb conjugation

Remember:

« to go to the » is expressed as:

ir a + infinitive --> Yo voy a comprar unos regalos.

Vocabulary :

Utilize vocabulary that we have learned throughout the year. Be creative with it. Use of rich vocabulary will result in a much more creative and unique journal.

Presentation format:

- Typed and printed out, with appropriate illustrations (clip art) for each entry.
- Power Point – with appropriate illustrations (clip art)for each entry.

- Blank journals can be provided. If you prefer to hand write your journal entries for more authenticity, the handwriting must be very neat and easy to read. Use appropriate illustrations.
 - You are responsible for drawings/pictures/stickers/clipart and text. However, I may have *some* stickers you can use. **Which ever method you choose, neatness counts!**
