To conjugate an ar verb in the present tense, remove the ar and add the following endings:

yo ___o	nosotros ___amos
tú ___as	vosotros ___áis
él, ella, usted ___a	ellos, ellas, ustedes ___an

### REGULAR ER VERBS

aprender - to learn  
beber - to drink  
comer - to eat  
comprender - to understand  
correr - to run  
deber - should  
leer - to read  
romper - to break  
vender - to sell

To conjugate an er verb in the present tense, remove the er and add the following endings.

yo ___o	nosotros ___emos
tú ___es	vosotros ___éis
él, ella, usted ___e	ellos, ellas, ustedes ___en

### REGULAR IR VERBS

abrir - to open  
compartir - to share  
decidir - to decide  
escribir - to write  
recibir - to receive  
subir - to go up  
vivir - to live

Remove the ir and add the following endings to ir verbs

yo ___o	nosotros ___imos
tú ___es	vosotros ___ís
él, ella, usted ___e	ellos, ellas, ustedes ___en

## JULY ASSIGNMENT #1 - STEM-CHANGING VERBS

### STEM CHANGING VERBS

Stem changing verbs have a change in a letter in the stem in all forms except nosotros and vosotros. BE CAREFUL TO LOOK AT THE INFINITIVE ENDING AND ADD THE PROPER ENDINGS TO THESE VERBS. Study the following stem changing verbs.

e>ie

cerrar - to close  
cierro cerramos  
cierras cerráis  
cierra cierran

Other e>ie verbs

comenzar - to begin      pensar - to think  
empezar - to begin      perder - to lose  
entender - to understand      preferir - to prefer  
merendar - to snack      querer - to want

o>ue

volver - to return  
vuelvo volvemos  
vuelves volvéis  
vuelve vuelven

Other verbs like volver

almorzar - to eat lunch      dormir - to sleep  
contar - to count / tell      encontrar - to find  
costar - to cost      jugar - to play a sport  
devolver - to return      poder - to be able to  
an object      recordar - to remember

e>i

pedir - to order / ask for  
pido pedimos  
pides pedís  
pide piden

Other verbs like pedir

repetir - to repeat  
servir - to serve

## JULY ASSIGNMENT #2 - IRREGULAR VERBS

### VERBS WITH AN IRREGULAR YO FORM

These verbs have an **irregular yo form** that you have to memorize. All the other forms of these verbs are regular

caer - to fall  
**caigo** caemos  
caes caéis  
cae caen

#### Other verbs with irregular forms

conocer / conozco - to know a person  
dar / doy - to give  
hacer / hago - to do / make  
poner / pongo - to put  
saber / sé - to know a fact  
salir / salgo - to leave  
traer / traigo - to bring  
ver / veo - to see

### VERBS WITH AN IRREGULAR FORM AND A STEM CHANGE

These verbs have an irregular yo form that you have to memorize and a stem change in the tú, él (ella, usted) and ellos (ellas, ustedes) forms.

decir (e>i) - to say / to tell  
**digo** decimos  
dices decís  
dice dicen

#### Other irreg. yo verbs with a stem change

tener/tengo (e>ie) - to have  
venir/vengo (e>ie) - to come  
seguir/sigo (e>i) - to follow

### OTHER IRREGULAR VERBS

You have to memorize the forms of these verbs. They are used often.

ser - to be  
soy somos  
eres sois  
es son

ir - to go  
voy vamos  
vas vais  
va van

estar - to be  
estoy estamos  
estás estáis  
está están

oír - to hear  
oigo oímos  
oyes oís  
oye oyen
