1. Go to Quia.com, log in.
2. Go to your class web page.
3. Look at week 1, (Semana 1). Make sure you have completed all tasks on week 1.
4. Look at week 2, (Semana 2). Make sure you have completed all tasks on week 2. *You had work due on StudySpanish.com last week. Please set up this account if you have not. The instructions are on Quia.* When you log in to StudySpanish.com, go to the syllabus on the left side of the screen and click on any the highlighted dates. They will take you to your past due and future assignments.
