

How to Review an Assignment on Quia

Once an assignment has been graded and posted into Pinnacle, you are able to review it in order to understand your grade, ask questions, and make improvements to your study strategies.

Step One

Login to your Quia account from the Quia home page.

Step Two

From this screen, you can view all of your completed assignments, as well as activities when applicable.

Step Three

Select the icon to the left of the assignment and click. Selecting the link will take you to the assignment, not the feedback page.

Step Four

Once you've selected your answers, you can view questions in their entirety. In the example below, you can see the original question (as it was presented on the quiz), acceptable answers, and your response. If I made a comment, you can see that below. Please make sure to read instructor comments whenever they are provided so you can identify areas of improvement.
