

Pope John Paul II – 4th Grade Supply List 2011-2012

Supplies your student will need*:

- **1 24-count box of crayons** – I am very lenient about crayons. Students may have fancy crayons – such as Twistables, if you wish. Larger size packs, such as 48 or 64, are also acceptable but not necessary. A basic 24 pack is fine.
- **1 package of markers**
- **1 package of colored pencils**
- **Small plastic supply box** – there is no room in your child’s desk for a larger size box.
- **2 large glue sticks** (No glue bottles, please.)
- **2 boxes of tissues** (for class use) More will be needed later in the year.
- **40 plain #2 pencils** (This is one pencil per week of school.) These pencils will stay in the classroom, so you will need others at home for your child’s homework or in his/her bookbag if he/she goes to aftercare. I am incredibly strict about pencils – **no fancy pencils, please!** The coating on the decorator pencils ruins the pencil sharpener. No mechanical pencils, please.
- **3 packs of wide ruled notebook paper** (Your child will need some to keep at home for homework, as well.)
- **2 packs of index cards** (any size, any color)
- **2 highlighters** (one yellow, one any other color)
- **1 pack of post em notes** (any color or shape)
- **1 white polymer eraser** (not pink pet eraser)
- **1 pair of school scissors**
- **1 plastic ruler with standard and metric measurements**
- **1 ream of white copy paper**
- **1 large container of Clorox wipes**
- **1 roll of paper towels**
- **1 art smock (old shirt)**
- **1 package of dry erase markers**
- **6 solid color pocket folders, 3 hole punched** (red, blue, green, yellow, purple, orange)
- **1 dictionary**
- **1 ½ inch three-ring binder (with clear pocket in front)** – please do not get a bigger binder or a trapper-keeper – there isn’t enough room in your student’s desk

*Except for each child’s BEAR binder (homework binder) and backpacks, these items remain in the classroom and are not brought home for homework. Students will need to have the following items available at home for homework – crayons or colored pencils, paper, pencils, scissors, glue or glue stick, ruler with centimeter and inches, and highlighter
