The Writing Process



Prewriting is the first step of the writing process in which you may use brainstorming, clusters, webs, or charts.



Drafting is the second stage of the writing process in which you will write quickly, guess at spelling, cross out and use abbreviations.



Revising is the third stage of the writing process in which you will "re-think" your writing. You may add information, or omit unnecessary information. Use descriptive words!



Editing is when you proofread and look for mistakes in spelling, capitalization, and punctuation.



Publishing is when you write a final, neat copy of your work with all of the corrections made.
