Classroom Responsibilities

1. Bring all books and materials to class.

Everyday, you should have your textbook, Language Arts notebook, wide-ruled notebook paper, and a pencil or pen. Supplies such as paper, pencil, or lead will not be lent out. Come prepared!

2. Be in your assigned seat when the bell rings. Stay in your seat unless you have permission otherwise.

If you are not in your seat when the bell rings, you are considered tardy. The tardy policy will be followed as listed in your student handbook. Students are to immediately begin working on their "At the Bell" assignment which will be on the board each day.

3. Politely raise your hand and wait for permission to speak.

Everyone will have the chance to speak and participate in the class. In order to maintain a proper learning environment, you must raise your hand and wait for acknowledgement from the teacher before speaking.

4. Listen to directions the first time they are given.

When the teacher is speaking, you are to listen. No exceptions!

5. Keep all personal belongings under your desk.

Your materials for this class should be the only things out on your desk. Cell phones, musical devices, perfume, lotion, make-up, etc. should not be out during class time. All electronic items (cell phones, MP3 players, CD/DVD players, etc.) if **seen, heard, used, or turned on** during class time will be confiscated according to the policy outlined in the student handbook.

If you choose to break a rule . . .

1st Offense: Warning.

2nd Offense: Written Discipline Drill. Parental signature required.

3rd Offense: After school detention. Parent/Guardian contacted.

4th Offense: Discipline Referral to the Office.

SEVERE DISRUPTION: Student sent immediately to the office.

Leaving the Classroom

Distractions that take away from classroom time will be kept at an absolute minimum. Each term, students will receive a "Potty/Locker Pass" that allows them to use the restroom on three occasions and go to their lockers on three occasions. Any student who turns in an unused pass at the end of the term will receive extra credit points.
