



Materials List: Language Arts

Required:

- English Notebook: You will need a specific 3-ring binder for this class period with only English materials in it. You will need the following dividers in your notebook:
 - A. At the Bell
 - B. Daily Grammar Practice (DGP)
 - C. Vocabulary
 - D. Reader's Notebook
 - E. Writing
- Index Cards: You will need several index cards that are ringed together. You can buy them pre-ringed or buy individual cards and rings to make them yourself. We are using these for our vocabulary lessons and will gradually create more and more. Eventually, you will need to have a total of 126 cards. You can buy them up front or add to them as needed – your preference. Plan to have at least 6 cards with you each week.
- For every class period, you must bring a pen or pencil and WIDE-RULED paper. Assignments done on college-ruled paper may not be accepted. Any type or color of pen or pencil is acceptable, but please remember that no lead will be supplied. Use lead pencils at your own risk!

Optional:

- Tissue boxes, hand sanitizer, or Clorox wipes are always a helpful addition to the classroom. They help to keep us all healthy. Any contribution you would like to make would be gladly accepted.
- Materials for projects, such as markers, colored pencils, crayons, glue sticks, or small scissors. Any of these materials that you could contribute would be a great help to us. We do many projects throughout the year that require these items, and of course, they run out fast.
- I do recommend that you create some type of assignment book for yourself.
