

<p>place from which</p> <p>expresses the place <u>from which</u> someone or something is coming</p> <p>e.g.: nuntius <i>ab castris</i> venit viri <i>de monte</i> currunt socii <i>ex provincia</i> fugiunt</p> <p><i>Romā</i> excedunt <i>Carthagine</i> iter fecimus</p>	<p><u>ablative</u></p>	<p><u>ab/ a</u> (meaning <i>from/ away from</i>)</p> <p><u>de</u> (meaning <i>from/ down from</i>)</p> <p><u>ex/ e</u> (meaning <i>from/ out from/ out of</i>)</p> <p><i>Nota bene:</i> with names of cities, towns, and small islands and with <i>domo</i> and <i>rure</i> – <i>no preposition</i></p>
<p>extent of space/how far</p> <p>expresses <i>how far</i> something extends or <i>how far</i> someone moves</p> <p>e.g.: puella <i>viginti pedes</i> natavit casa <i>decem pedes</i> alta est <i>multa milia</i> passuum navigavi</p>	<p><u>accusative</u></p>	<p><i>no preposition</i></p>
