DOUGLAS A. ROTHSCHILD

For over 28 years Mr. Rothschild played a major role in the development of the high technology and communications industry. Through his senior management assignments, with many of the industry's most influential corporations, he had been a facilitator of the global information revolution that occurred over the last three decades of the twentieth century .

Mr. Rothschild has held senior executive management positions with such leading Fortune 500 corporations as IBM , Lucent , Nortel Networks , and MCI / Verizon . In roles with these organizations Mr. Rothschild was responsible for the management of global operating divisions that employed hundreds of employees across the United States and Europe. A number of these operating divisions produced over 250 million in annual revenue and grew over 30 % annually during the 1980s and 1990s.

Many of these start – ups were privately owned companies that specialized in communications hardware, software, and professional technical services. As a senior executive with such companies as Madge Networks and Web Associates, Mr. Rothschild's management expertise helped lead these companies to exponential growth, their initial public offerings, and their eventual mergers and acquisitions.

In addition to his business interests, Mr. Rothschild's first, and most valued, professional passion has always been teaching and coaching. Having prepared for a career as an educator, and knowing that he would someday return to a teaching assignment, he has worked at maintaining his professional teaching credentials since 1975. In 2002 Mr. Rothschild made the decision to return to the field of education and has been a master teacher of social sciences and business courses at both the college and high school level.
