Using school digital cameras (or your personal one) and the iPhoto program on the Macs, you will upload digital photos. You will learn about memory cards and card readers. Some of the camera features will be explained, such as Macro and stop action photos. You will learn about the slideshow feature in iPhoto, using music to present your digital photos. You will print out your 5 final photos using your flash drive and the photo printers in the lab. You can enhance your photos using the iPhoto features or import them into Photoshop Elements to manipulate them. Remember to check your batteries & clear your memory cards before class!

- * Wilderness Adventure photos are encouraged, along with other class trips
- * Print out 5 photos in these categories:
people, architecture, nature, action, and a favorite shot (hopefully "artsy"!)
- * Make a collage of these photos to display on the walls in the computer lab
