<p>Create a board game based on some aspect of Greek mythology. This could be a game about the Greeks' concept of the Underworld, the twelve labors of Hercules, or even the major gods and goddesses.</p>	<p>Create a booklet on the influence of Greek mythology on today's society. Take pictures, find advertisements, or cut out company information on businesses with Greek myths in their names or logos (ex. Pegasus on the Marathon building in downtown Dallas or FTD florists).</p>	<p>Draw a comic strip about one of the Greek heroes and tell his story through art. Your comic strip must have a minimum of 10 frames.</p>
<p>Create a PowerPoint presentation on a myth of your choice. Your presentation must contain detailed information and show research from a number of sources. You must also include information where you found your sources.</p>	<p>You can write a formal essay on "Heroism". In this essay, you will need to compare and contrast two heroes from two different myths.</p>	<p>Create a trifold and inform on three of any of the following relating to your myth.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Tension between opposing forces in the universe -A struggle for power -Explanation of the Origins of Life and the Natural World -Fate and Prophecy -Supernatural or Nonhuman Characters -A Quest or Completion of a Task
<p>Create an original myth. Design your "character" and plan his/her story. Write the story in a booklet or blank book, illustrating the story with original drawings or clip art that is appropriate. Be prepared to read your myth to the class.</p>	<p>You create a pyramid foldable and explain "The Lesson" for three myths.
