

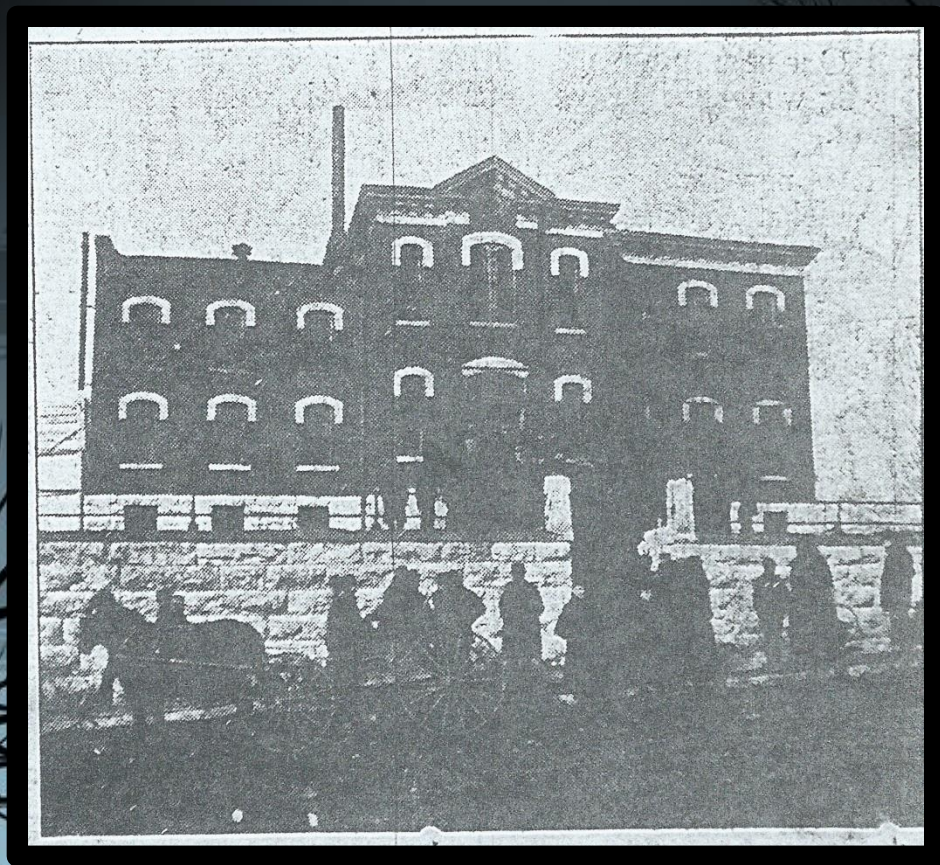

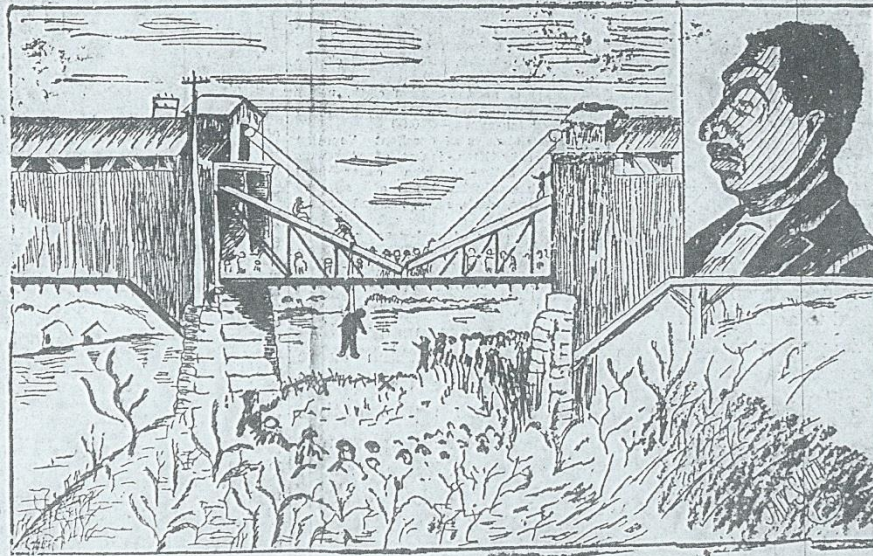

ANOTHER PHOTOGRAPH OF THE WARD BURNING—Remarkable because the faces of several well-known Terre Hauteans are clearly recognizable. Speaking of it, the Indianapolis Press says:

"This picture of the burning of George Ward, the negro murderer of Miss Ida Finkelstein, was sent to the Vigo county members of the legislature today. It is said to be the only photograph ever taken of such a scene. It shows the faces of a score of the members of the mob, so that they may be easily recognized. One of the men was so proud that he removed his hat to have his picture taken. Many of the men have brushwood in their hands, to replenish the fire over the negro's body. The feet and legs of the negro are seen protruding from the burning heap, the hob-nailed shoe on the right being particularly distinct. It was Ward's hob-nailed shoes that enabled the detectives to track him from the scene of the murder."

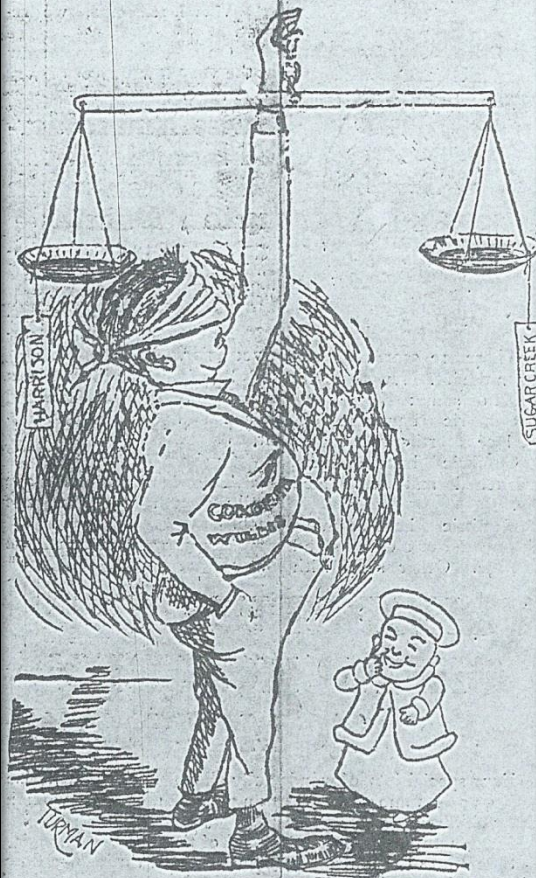
THE BLACK BRUTE KILLED BY A MOB.
