An invisible gas. Usually does not react or combine with other substances.

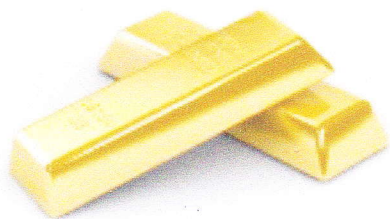
Made of oats, sugar, starch, calcium carbonate and other ingredients.

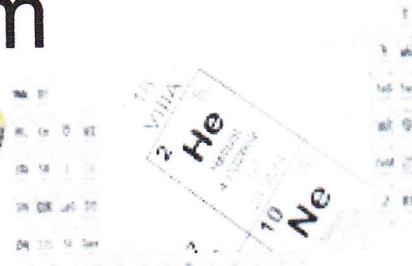
