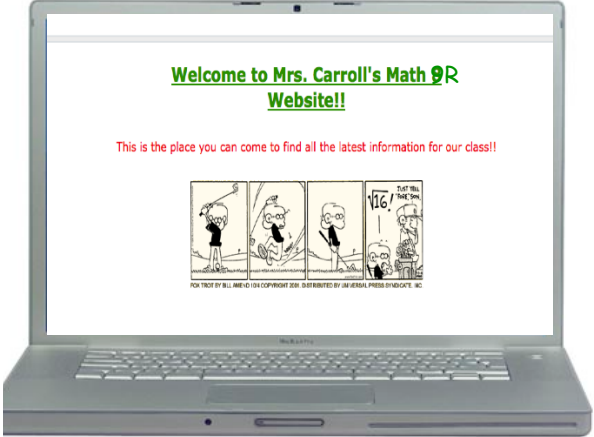
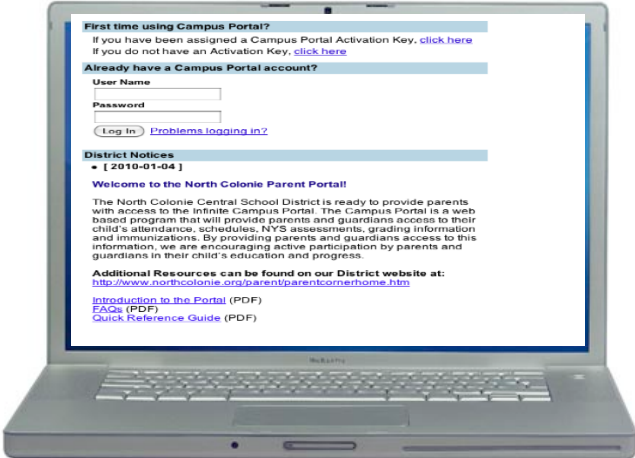

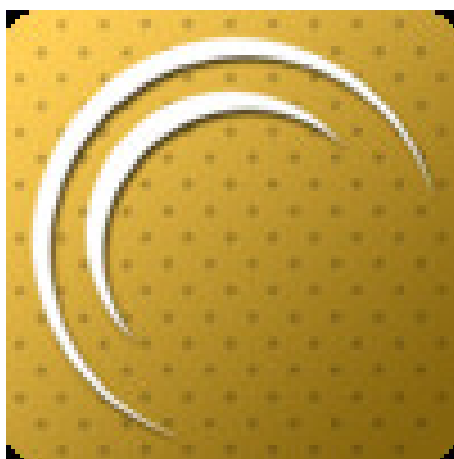

When you read your grade report, you may see some codes that you are unsure of. The following is a key for those codes.

- “m” means missing. This means the student may turn in the late assignment for half credit. (The “m” will be replaced with a zero, once the unit has been completed, and the opportunity to hand in the assignment has passed)
- “A” means absent, and the assignment will be noted as missing. This means the student may turn in that assignment for full credit. (The “A” will be replaced with a zero, once the unit has been completed, and the opportunity to hand in the assignment has passed)
- Once a grade is marked with a zero, that means that it is too late to hand in the assignment. I will usually note why they received a zero.
- “r” means redo, once this assignment is redone, it will receive full credit

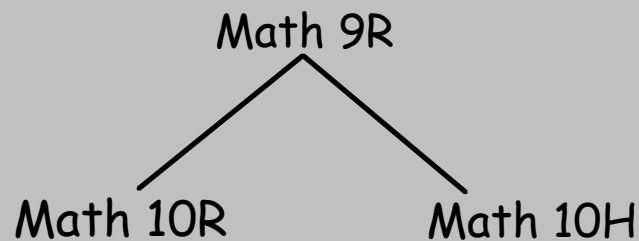
