## 2.2: Adding Real Numbers

Goals: \*Add numbers with same signs

\*Add numbers with different signs

## **Same Signs:**

1. Keep the sign

Ex: -7 + (-10) -17

2. Add the numbers

Ex: -11.5 + (-2.7) -14.2

## **Different Signs:**

1. Keep the sign of the bigger number

Ex: -21 + 6 - 15

2. Subtract

Ex: -12.6 + 7.3 - 5.3

Ex: The table shows how much weight two dieters lost or gained per month.

- a) Find the total amount of weight lost by each dieter. Dieter A: -7.9 Dieter B: -7.4
- b) Which dieter had the greater weight loss at the end of three months?

Dieter A lost more

Month	Dieter A	Dieter B
1	-3.3	-7.8
2	-5.1	1.2
3	0.5	-0.8

**Ex:** The table below shows the profits of two piano companies over the course of 3 years. (Positive profit means the company made money, while a negative profit means the company lost money)

- a) Find the profits for both companies, then decide which piano manufacturer had the greatest profits after 3 years? Company A: 9.7 Company B: 9.6 Company A made more
- b) How much more money did this company make? 0.1 more
