

BOOK REVIEW SPHERE

Materials you will need: a 12-inch length of string, scissors, glue, crayons or markers, and a hole punch.

1. After filling out each section of the sphere, carefully cut out each strip and use a hole punch to make a hole in the center of each strip.
2. Place a small dot of glue around each hole punched in the three strips. Place the strips, evenly spaced, one on top of the other. (Figure 1)
3. Place a small dot of glue on the tab of each strip. Attach each strip's tab to its opposite end. (Figure 2)
4. Cut out the circle pattern. Use a hole punch to make a hole at the top of the circle. Illustrate two different scenes from the book, one on each side of the circle.
5. Tie a 12-inch length of string to the hole in the top of the illustrated circle. Insert the circle into the middle of the sphere. Then thread the string up through the holes in the strips of the sphere. (Figure 3)

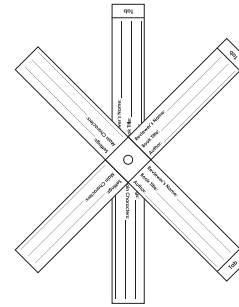

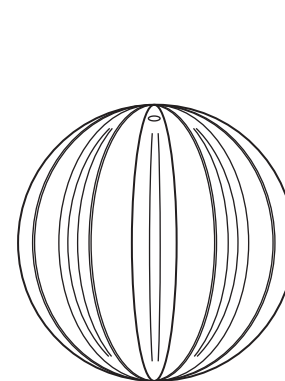
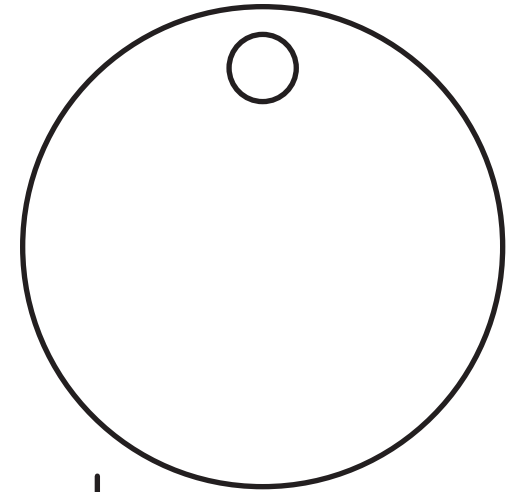

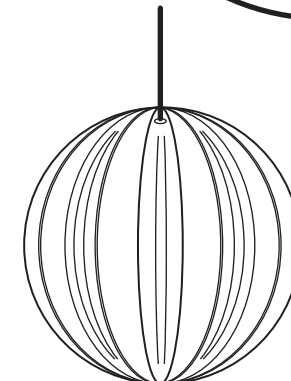
