

Brown Bag Speech

30 points: 10 for Outline, 10 for Content, 10 for Delivery

Objective – Student will be able to construct and perform a ^{ONE} ~~one~~ minute speech describing their self-concept, identity, and goals.

Assignment – Bring in an item (which is no bigger than a brown paper lunch bag) that symbolize something about your past/present/future or reflects your likes/dislikes/goals/wishes. Consider an object that shows diversity about you, such as how strangers see you, how parents see you, friends see you, you see yourself, etc.

A typed **outline** of your speech will be due at the time of your performance. You will turn it in *before* you deliver the presentation.

Notes - Try to think of an interesting or unusual item that will clearly tell the class who you are and what's important to you. Avoid items that you would ordinarily bring to school with you. Of course, nothing that violates School Board policy or classroom rules will be allowed.

You should come to class with object, and will not be permitted to retrieve it once you arrive in class on the day you are scheduled to present.

* School Supplies DO NOT count as the object!!!
