Structure	Structure Tags – <i>Must</i> appear on every page!!		
HTML	<code><html></code> <code></html></code>	<code><html></code> Text in here describes the webpage <code></html></code>	Tells WWW that this is an HTML document.
Head	<code><head></code> <code></head></code>	<code><head></code> <code><title>Title of the document</title></code> <code></head></code>	Add info that will not appear on page
Title	<code><title></code> <code></title></code>	<code><title>Title of the document</title></code>	Places title of page in (blue) browser bar
Body	<code><body></code> <code></body></code>	<code><html></code> <code><body></code> Text in here is the visible page content <code></body></code> <code></html></code>	Encloses section of page that will be displayed in the browser
Content	Add organization and interest to a webpage.		
Headings	<code><h1></code> largest, through <code><h6></code> , smallest	<code><h1>This is a large heading</h1></code>	Increase/decrease text size
Paragraph (double space)	<code><p></code> <code></p></code>	<code><p>This is a paragraph</p></code>	Separates sections by adding a blank line
Line Break (single space)	<code>
</code>	<code><p>This is a paragraph with
 line breaks</p></code>	Creates a new line as if using the ENTER key; no extra space
Unordered List	<code></code> <code></code> <code></code>	<code></code> <code>Coffee</code> <code>Tea</code>	Creates a bulleted list • Monday

Ordered List	<code></code> <code> </code> <code></code>	<code></code> <code>Coffee</code> <code>Tea</code> <code>Milk</code> <code></code>	Creates a numbered list 1. Monday 2. Tuesday 3. Wednesday
Horizontal Rule	Place at end <code><hr/></code>	<code><p>This is text above the rule.</p></code> <code><hr /></code> <code><p>This is text below the rule.</p></code>	Creates horizontal lines on page
Bold	<code></code> <code></code>	<code><p>This text is bold</p></code>	Creates bold text
Italics	<code><i></code> <code></i></code>	<code><p><i>This text is italic</i></p></code>	Creates <i>italicized</i> text
Image	<code></code>	<code>++</code>	Embeds an image in an HTML page

Type of Tag	HTML Tag	Example (Answers will vary)	Function
Linking	<code><a href></code>	<code>this is a link</code>	Creates a link to another document
Comment	<code><!-- text here--></code>	<code><!--This is a comment. Comments are not displayed in the browser--></code>	Inserts a comment that appears in the code but is not displayed in the browser.
