

# Foundations of Servant Leadership Syllabus

## 2011-2012

**Instructors:** Mr. K

**Text:** Anything that is handed out in class or notes collected by the students.

### **Grading Policy:**

Each Student must earn 10 points per day in class. You earn these points by:

- 1) You have all of you required materials **at your seat** on time
- 2) You participate in class and are productive in a positive way

This is a participation based class. Your grade is completely dependant on you. If you engage in conversations and take notes you will receive full credit each day.

### **Tests:**

Tests it will count for 100 points each. A weeks notice will always be given. Most tests will be an essay based on the discussions in class. Most tests will be graded on how well you defend your opinion and of course proper writing skills. All written tests will be completed in class.

### **Quizzes:**

Quizzes will count for 50 points. No pop quizzes.

### **Projects/Activities:**

Projects will be assigned with ample time to complete the project. Projects are worth 300 points. Students will be expected to complete projects on time.

### **Notebooks:**

Because this classes curriculum is based on discussions and handouts. Each student is required to have a 3 ringed binder to collect this data. There will be 3 sections in this notebook: 1) Handouts, 2) Notes (your personal class notes, please date each set of notes according to the discussion dates) and the last section will be for 3) Tests and Quizzes. This notebook is designed for you to continue to build on as you grow through life. This notebook will be checked each 9 weeks and is worth 200 points each 9 weeks.

### **Journal:**

Students will maintain a Journal on the discussions had in class. They will be instructed as to which days and topics to discuss in their Journal entries. Students will need a black and white composition book. Each Journal Entry (at least a half a page) will count as 25 points each and be graded on completion and proper writing skills.

**Required Materials:** Each student is expected to have the following every day:

- 1) Pencil/pen
- 2) Notebook (3 ring binder)
- 3) Books
- 4) Homework

**Make-up Policy: You may make up any test that was missed due to an excused absence before the end of the quarter.**
