## Installing the Classical Greek Keyboard from Keyman

These instructions were written using version 14 of Keyman on a Windows PC in June, 2021. The Keyman app allows you to type in Greek.


**1.** Download the Keyman application by choosing the green *Download* button from the correct web page below. It looks like this:

- Install the application (the exact process is specific to your device)
- ☐ 3. Install the keyboard (Greek Classical)
  - a. Open *Keyman Configuration* if it does not open automatically after installation



b. Click the orange *Download keyboard...* button at the bottom of the window. It looks like this:



- c. In the search box type Greek Classical (note word order)
- d. Click on the *Greek Classical* heading to download and install the keyboard

- ☐ 4. **Configure Keyman** to function as you wish
  - a. In Keyman Configuration, select Hotkeys from the menu on the left
    - i. Find "Ancient Greek" under Keyboard Layouts
    - ii. Click the "(none)" hyperlink on the right
    - iii. Type the hotkey combination that will switch from your default English keyboard to the Classical Greek keyboard; Keyman will memorize the key combination that you type (I use ALT+Z, but you can use any combination that works for you)
  - b. In Keyman Configuration, select **Options** from the menu on the left
    - i. Make sure the first *General* option ("Keyboard hotkeys toggle keyboard activation") is checked
    - ii. Under *Startup*, choose whether you want Keyman to start automatically whenever you turn on your computer, or if you want to always turn it on manually

## ☐ 5. **Test Keyman**

- a. Open any word processing program
- b. Toggle keyman on by hitting your hotkey combination
- c. Type several keys to ensure you're typing in Greek. Note that accents will only work over vowels and breathing marks will only work over vowels and  $\rho$  (rho).
- d. Toggle keyman off by hitting your hotkey combination again
