Verb Conjugation in The Present Tense LESSON 2

The verb endings, in **bold** type below, are always the same, no matter which verb, no matter which tense.

The verbs <u>Ir</u> & <u>Ser</u> are very special verbs, and they are always treated differently. Also, the Preterite tense has to be learned separately, because it does not follow patterns like the other tenses.

COMER: to eat

NOTE: "Yo" ending (unpredictable)

Any other verb ending (other than s, a/e, mos, is, n, or R) would be the Yo ending. (EXCEPT: In the Preterite tense, and with the verbs, Ir & Ser)

Matching Verb Endings & Subjects

So we can say **:

S = Tú (*You*)

a/e= vd., él, OR ella (You-sir, ma'am, He, She)

N = Vds. ellos, OR ellas (You all; They)

MOS = Nosotros (We)

IS= Vosotros (You all)

R= The VerbName (To)

** EXCEPT: (i) In past tenses the 'yo' form often has the same ending as the 'Vd., él, ella 'form.; (ii) In the Future tense the 'yo' ending is "é".

Finding Meaning and Subjects in Verbs

In every verb we can find at least two things that help us understand it:

Meaning (the first part of the verb)

Subject (the verb ending)

Finding Meaning and Subjects in Verbs

Although each form of this verb (below) looks very different you know they all have the same basic meaning ("eat"), by looking at the first part of the verb, "com":

EXAMPLE

CO	MER:	to	eat
----	------	----	-----

Yo (1)	com o	com ía	com eré	com ería	
Tú (You)	comes	com ías	comerás	com erías	S
Ël, ella, Vd. (He, She, You)	com e	com ía	come rá	com ería	a/e

Vosotros (You all)	com éis	com íais	com eréis	com eríais	IS
Ellos, ellas, Vds. (They, You all)	com en	com ían	com erán	com erían	N

Finding Meaning and Subjects in Verbs

OTHER EXAMPLES:

Hablas: Habl= talk, s= You You talk OR You are talking.

Hablamos:: Habl=talk, mos= We WE talk OR We are talking.

Camína<mark>n:</mark> Camín= walk, n= They They walk; OR They are walking.

Camína<mark>n:</mark> Camín= walk, n= You all (Vds.) You all (Vds.) walk; OR You all (Vds.) are walking.

Camína<mark>mos</mark>:: camín= walk, mos= We We walk; OR We are walking.

adoptais: adopt= adopt, is= You all, You all adopt OR You all are adopting.
