B. Subject Pronoun: Yo, Tú, Vd. Él, Ella, Nosotros, Vosotros, Vds. Ellos, Ellas, Which plural pronoun should be used in place of a 'mixed' plural subject?

Forming Sentences in the Plural

(Knowing which subject pronoun & matching verb ending to use)

FORMULA

1st. 'I' + noun/pronoun = 'We'

2nd. 'You' + noun/ pronoun = 'You' all

3rd. 'He'/'She'/'It', + noun(s) = 'They'

1st. If the 'mixed' plural subject of the verb includes 'I': Use the 'We' (Nosotros) ending of the verb

2nd. If the plural subject of the verb includes 'You' (but not 'I') = Use the 'You' all'* (Ustedes) ending of the verb**

3rd. If the plural subject of the verb includes a noun, 'He'/'She'/'It',' (but not 'I' or 'You') = Use the 'They* (Ellos/Ellas) ending of the verb

*NOTE: Plural of 'Vd.' (You)= Ustedes

NOTE: Plural of 'Tú' (You)= Ustedes

** except in Spain

100 (a hundred) girls and 9 boys run in the park.	= They run in the park.
Mary, Susan, and my mother live here.	= They live here.
My group and the boy eat in the cafeteria.	= They eat in the cafeteria.
My friends, all my family, my school, and my country eat icecream.	= They eat icecream.
1,000 (a thousand) girls and a boy turn around.	= They turn around,

100 (cien) chicas y 9 chicos corren en las Olimpiadas.*	= Ellos corren en las Olimpiadas.
Mary, Susan, y mi madre viven aquí. (All female subjects = female plural: Ellas)	= Ellas viven aquí.
Mi grupo y el niño comen en la cafetería.*	= Ellos comen en la cafetería.
Mis amigas, toda mi familia, mi escuela, y mi país comen el helado. *	= Ellos comen el helado
1,000 (mil) chicas y un chico dan vuelta*	= Ellos dan vuelta

*(Mix of male & female subjects = masculine plural: Ellos)

*(general subjects, or subjects of unknown gender = masculine plural: Ellos)

Verb Conjugation in The Present Tense

LESSON 7- Finding the Correct Subject Pronouns & Matching Verb Endings

If the <u>subject of the verb is a single noun</u>: **Use the He'/'She'/'It** (Él/Ella)*+ **ending of the verb**

(4th.) rule Single *noun* = 'He'/'She'/'It' **Single Noun Subject Subject Pronoun** = 'He'/'She'/'It', Single *noun* Jerry eats a lot. = **He** eats a lot The boy runs in the park. = **He** runs in the park. My mother lives here. = **She** lives shere. Susan eats icecream. = **She** eats icecream. = **She** turns around. The girl turns around. The house is big. = It is big. The book is small. = It is small

*+ In Spanish there is no special word for 'it'

Él = He, it; Ella= She, it

verb Conjugation in The Present Tense

If the <u>subject of the verb is a single noun</u>: Use the He'/'She'/'It (Él/Ella)*+ ending of the verb

In Spanish

4th. rule

Single noun = 'El'/'Ella" *+

Single Noun Subject	Subject Pronoun = 'Él'/'Ella'
Single noun	
Jerry come mucho.	=Él come mucho.
El niño corre en el parque.	= ÉI corre en el parque.
Mi madre vive aquí.	= Ella vive aquí.
Susan come helado.	= Ella come helado.
La niña da vuelta.	= Ella da vuelta.
La casa es grande.	= Ella es grande.
El libro es pequeño.	= Él es pequeño.

*+ In Spanish there is no special word for 'it'.

Él = He, it; Ella= She, it
