

# 2024 National Latin Exam Results



## Lukeion Project Statistics

All Lukeion students are invited to take the NLE with no qualifying scores except for those that plan to retake the Latin level a second time. This year, **153** Lukeion students took the National Latin Exam in 6 levels, not including Intro (which we do not offer). **138** of those students earned honors this year. Self-reported scores will be added to these results when they are received but they are not calculated into our reported percentages here.

## School Honors Report for 2024

- **90% of Lukeion Project Latin students earned honors**
- **49% of those who earned an honor earned a GOLD medal**
- **13% (9 students) of those that earned a gold medal, *ALSO earned a "perfect paper" certificate / perfect score***
- **33% of those who earned an honor earned a SILVER medal**

Proof of your success on this exam is your certificate (all who earn honors get a certificate) and gold/silver medal for those who earned that level. You will not receive additional documentation of your score besides this handout.

Certificates and medals will be sent to you by mail once all award materials have been sent to the Lukeion office, usually in June.

Highschool seniors: if you have taken 3 successive levels of the NLE and earned a gold on all of those levels (not including Intro) you may be sent an invitation to apply for a Latin scholarship. I will forward these letters to you by email. **You will have a very short window of time to apply for that scholarship** so apply quickly once those letters arrive in your inbox.

**NOTA BENE:** If you took this exam and your name does not appear on the honors list below, this means you placed at or below the national average and did not earn an honor this year. Contact your instructor by email for your numeric result which will not be shared here in this document.

There were 40 questions on the exam except for advanced levels which feature longer translations and fewer questions. **Awards are based on point values above the national median score** for each level. Below are the ranges for honors for students who took that level for the first time. **Students who repeated the level for any reason** (marked with \*) were held to a different range of scores for earning honors.

## Did you earn a gold medal in Latin III or above?

***If you are a senior this year and have taken 3 consecutive gold medals, you may be eligible to apply for a college scholarship if you plan to continue the study of Latin in college. You must submit your application and other documentation to the NLE Scholarship Chair.***

**How?** Special letters are mailed from the NLE office to the main Lukeion office. Mrs. Barr will forward your letter in your award packet **but look for a COPY to arrive by email first so you can get started on your application immediately.** The deadline will be VERY CLOSE to the arrival of your letter here at The Lukeion Project. *It is very easy to miss the scholarship deadline if you are not QUICK!*

### Special Awards

The NLE committee will mail Perfect Paper certificates and special book awards to Mrs. Barr sometime mid-summer. Once ***everything*** has arrived at The Lukeion Project, Mrs. Barr will forward your awards to you separately by mail. Nothing will be mailed until all award components have arrived.
