affectus, -us (m) – mood, fondness for

afficio, -afficere, affeci, affectum – treat, affect

castitas, -tatis (f) – chastity, purity

coniungio, coniungere, coniunxi, coniunctum – join together, marry (used for both men and women)

contemno, contemnere, contempsi, contemptum – scorn

contubernium, -i (n) – household, company

eligo, eligere, elegi, electrum – pick out, choose, select

lana, -ae (f) – wool, cloth

lateo, latere, latui – go into hiding, lie hidden

nubo, nubere, nupsi, nuptum (+dat) - cover, veil, marry (used mainly for women)

pariter (adv) – equally, at the same time as

paulatim (adv) – gradually

pietas, -tatis (f) – family loyalty or devotion

ploro (1) – weep aloud, wail, grieve, mourn

soleo, solera, solitus sum – be accustomed

tunc (adv) – then, at that time

tuba, -ae (f) – trumpet

torqueo, torquere, torsi, tortum – bend, twist

trutina, -ae (f) – scale, balance

velum, -i (n) – veil, curtain
