arx, arcis (f) – citadel, stronghold

calor, -oris (m) – fever (from passion or an illness)

clamo (1) - shout

finio, finire, finivi, finitum – end, finish, conclude, bound within limits

foveo, fovere, fovi, fotum – comfort, nurture, support

iter, itineris (n) – journey, trip, route, road

maestus, a, um (adj) – sad, sorrowful, dejected

nondum (adv) – not yet

nummus, -i (m) – coin

propinquus, a, um (adj) – near

requies, requietis (f) – rest from labor, respite

sicco (1) – dry, remove moisture from (related adjective = siccus, a, um)

tabesco, tabescere, tabui – waste away, dwindle, decompose

taedet, taedere, taedit – (impersonal) – it causes weariness or boredom

tristis, -e (adj) – sad, sorrowful, gloomy

ubique (adv) – anywhere, everywhere

unguentum, -i (n) – ointment, perfume, unguent

velut (adv) – as, even as, just as

vexo (1) – trouble, afflict
