adfligo, adfligere, adflixi, adflictum – knock down, damage, injure

aedificium, -i (n) – building, house

caedes, -is (f) – murder, slaughter

compleo, complere, complevi, completum - fill, complete

consido, considerare, consedi, concessum – sit down, settle, encamp

contagio, -onis (f) – contact

existimo (1) - form a judgement about, consider, regard, think

facinus, -oris (n) – action, deed (usually refers to a bad deed or crime)

furtum, -i (n) – theft, trick, stratagem

immolo (1) – sacrifice, immolate (originally sprinkle with sacred meal)

intereo, interire, interii, interium - perish, pass away

mando (1) – entrust, command

orior, oriri, ortus sum – arise, rise

pondus, -eris (n) – weight

praeda, -ae (f) – booty, plunder

praesum, praeese, praefui – be in charge (+dat)

procuro (1) – attend to, take care of

propulso (1) – fend off, drive back, repel

ramus, -i (m) – branch

voveo, vovere, vovi, votum – vow, promise solemnly
