**egregius, a, um (adj)** – outstanding, excellent

**frustra (adv)** – to no purpose, in vain

**gentilis, gentilis (m)** – member of the same clan, fellow countryman

**letum, -i (n)** - death

**numen, -inis (n)** – divine will, divinity

**posthac (adv)** – after this

**plane (adv)** – plainly, clearly, truly

**proinde (adv)** – accordingly, similarly

**salto (1)** - dance

**sermo, -onis (f)** – conversation, speech
