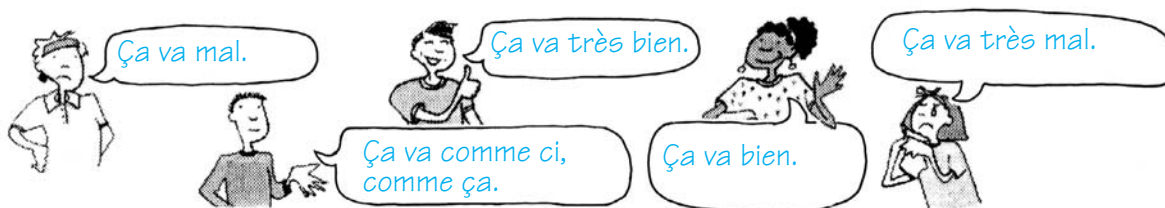
2. Bonjour!
