Restorative

Fillings are only covered when performed in a Short Procedure Unit (SPU), Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) or Inpatient Hospital for members who are unmanageable and require general anesthesia by an anesthesiologist, not the dentist, due to a severe mental and/or physical condition.

Prior Auth required!

Oral Surgery

Extractions are only covered when performed in a Short Procedure Unit (SPU), Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) or Inpatient Hospital.

Extractions (D7140) will be covered for members who are unmanageable and require general anesthesia by an anesthesiologist, not the dentist, due to a severe mental and/or physical condition.

Prior Auth required!

Adjunctive Services

(D9110): Palliative (emergency) treatment of dental pain, minor procedure is covered.

No Prior Auth required!

Probing...

After reviewing these benefits, the question we should be asking to the member or finding out from the provider is: are the services being rendered at a dental provider office?

- If the answer is YES, the only services/benefits the member has is D9110: Palliative (emergency) treatment of dental pain, minor procedure and one PA x-ray.
- All covered services must be performed at a Short Procedure Unit (SPU), Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) or Inpatient Hospital.
