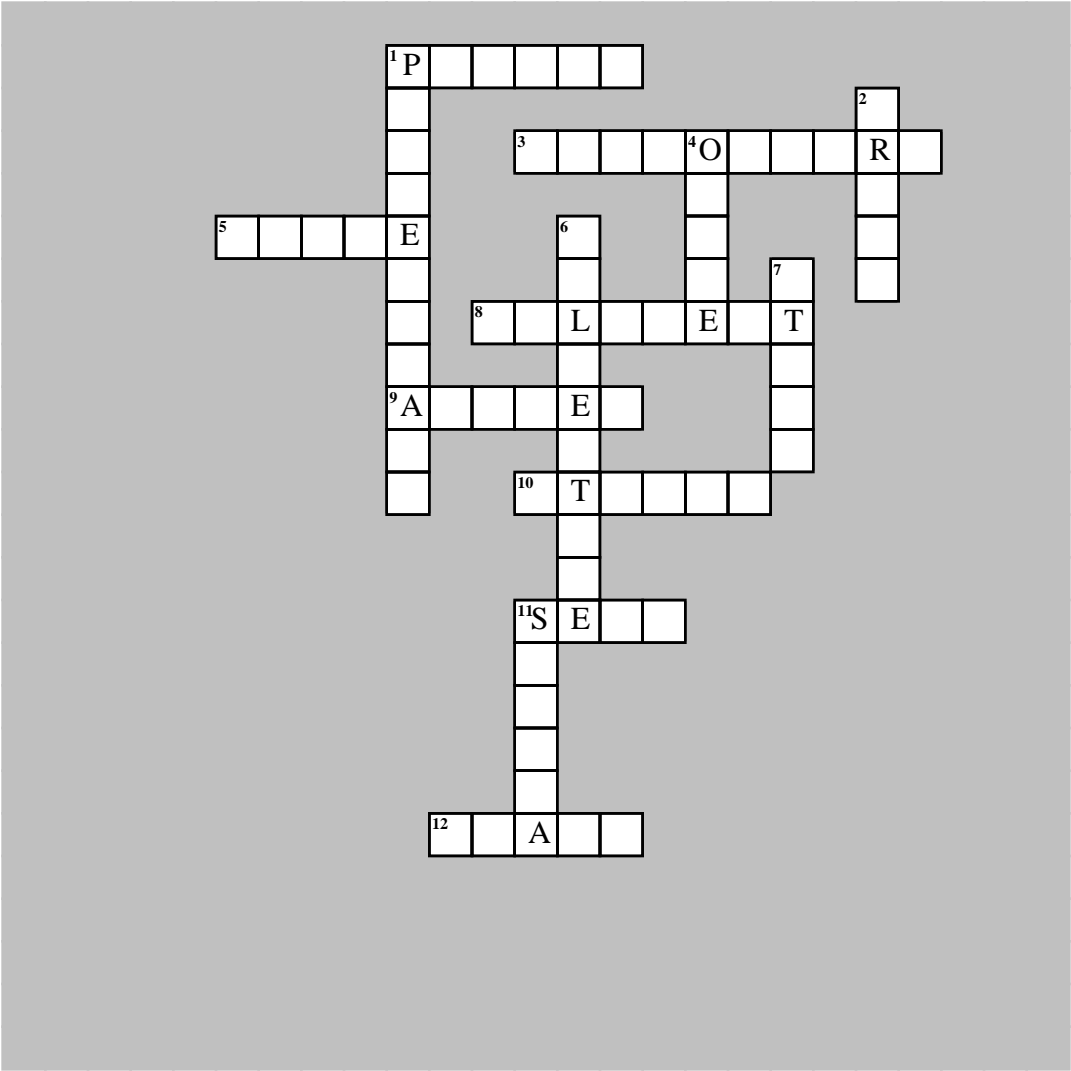

- 12 The organ that bears the ovules of a flower.
