## Faith: Chapel Reflection

To prepare for our Chapel Experience in the Faith unit, you will:

- 1. Choose one of the following:
  - a quote about faith that is personally meaningful to you and says something important about faith in your life. You may look for this on the web or in the Bible or in another religious book OR
  - b. A non-religious symbol (You must be creative! No crosses, prayer books or First Communion presents!) that represents an important part of your faith or what faith is in your life.
- 2. Presenting the quote or symbolic object:
  - a. Print out the quote using a decorative font and font size to fill the page (standard  $8 \% \times 11$  paper), adding color and design to make it eye-catching. You may use either portrait or landscape orientation. Tell to whom the quote is attributed or give the Bible citation.

OR

b. Take a snapshot of your symbol and print it out on regular paper and present it decoratively. Label the item so we know what it is.

You may use the creative capabilities of your iPad or computer programs to complete this entire project if you choose, but it MUST be colorful, creative and expressive of how you understand faith in your own life, lived now and/or over time in your faith experience.

- 3. On a separate sheet of paper, write a five or more sentence paragraph reflection explaining why this quote is meaningful to you and how you see it operating in your life, OR explaining the non-religious symbol you chose and how it represents your past/current experience of and attempts to live out your faith. Include your name and period.
- 4. Be prepared to explain to the class in chapel why the quote or the object is meaningful to you and speaks about your faith/ relationship with God.
- 5. Due: Thursday, September 26: 20 points
- 6. Grading:

a.	visual presentation of quote or item: 8 points	
b.	reflection about item and your faith: 8 points	
c.	presentation in chapel: 4 points	
d.	TOTAL: 20 points	

NOTE: Unprepared students will lose presentation points AND receive a 10% penalty the first day late; 50% penalty the second day assignment is late.
