**1. Dive Reservations**

To make a dive, whether for certification or pleasure, a reservation must be made. Reservations are to be made Monday through Friday prior to the desired dive date. This is done by making a phone call to Ocean Gear @ 714-375-0595 and leaving your name, phone number, date you wish to dive (Sat. or Sun.) and, most importantly, your height & weight. There are a limited number of reservations available and they are issued on a first come, first served basis. Unless there is a problem with your reservation, there will be **no returned phone call.**

**2. Reservation Confirmation**

Call Ocean Gear's office @ 714-375-0595 the evening before the dive date, after 7:00 p.m. Listen to the answering machine for any indication of scheduled dives being canceled. The diver has sole responsibility to determine if a scheduled dive will in fact take place. Every effort is made by Ocean Gear to make this information available in advance. There may be occasions when it is impossible to anticipate weather and dive conditions. On those events we will make that determination at the beach on the date of the dive.

**3. Beach Location and Directions**

Most all of our beach dives take place at Corona Del Mar. Located just south of Newport Beach, Corona Del Mar is one of the finest training beaches in Southern California. Directions will vary depending upon your location. You will take:

---

to the 73 Fwy South. Exit the 73 Fwy at MacArthur Blvd. Take MacArthur till it dead ends at Pacific Coast Highway (PCH). There you will make a left. Go to Marguerite (about 2 Stoplights) and make a right. This street will dead-end at Ocean Blvd. and you make a right. Corona Del Mar Main Beach will be posted about 100 yds. down. Parking is available down the driveway for a fee.

**4. Things to Bring**

You will always need to bring: a swim suit, a large ground pad, a lunch, towels (at least 2), warm clothing, gear rental money, sun tan grease, your choice of music, spray bottle w/ shampoo, and food for a BBQ (if offered).

**5. Starting and Ending Times**

Our dives always start at 8:00 a.m. Unfortunately we cannot be as precise as to when we finish. The dives being done and the number of people showing up to dive determine that. Typically you should expect to finish around 2:00 p.m., or so.

**6. Meet at the School \_\_\_\_\_ Leave the School \_\_\_\_\_ Arrive at the Beach at 8:00a.m.**

**7: Boots, Gloves and other Dive Equipment**

Unlike most other dive shops we do not require our students to purchase any SCUBA equipment. We strongly urge and recommend that students purchase boots and gloves. We make these available to our students at the beach for a substantially reduced price. The same is also true for personal gear packages including Mask, Snorkel and Fins. While there is no requirement to purchase these items, we offer several promotional packages that can offer significant savings to the diver if purchased at the beach. All other gear is available for rent. If the student has any other SCUBA gear, or buys from Ocean Gear, then the pre-arranged gear rental fee is reduced accordingly.
