1. Carries out Standard Steps A, B, C, D, and E as need indicates.			
2. Gathers equipment, checks order and current blood sugar reading.			
3. Checks expiration dates on vials of insulin.			
4. Performs hand hygiene.			
5. Swirls insulin suspension gently to mix well.			
6. Swabs the tops of both vials with antiseptic swab.			
7. Pulls air into the syringe in amount equal to the medication to be			
withdrawn from both vials.			
8. Injects air into cloudy suspension bottle in exact amount of dose to			
be later withdrawn.			
9. Injects air into the clear insulin vial.			
10. Withdraws the clear (Regular) insulin dose from the vial, keeping			
the bevel below the level of the liquid.			
11. Withdraws the cloudy suspension insulin (long-acting) from the			
vial, keeping the bevel below the level of the liquid.			
12. Replaces the sterile needle cap.			
13. Carries out Standard Steps X, Y, and Z.
