Key Issue 4

To reduce the gap between MDCs and LDCs, LDCs must develop more rapidly.

They have to increase GDP and use additional funds to improve social and economic conditions.

LDCs face two major obstacles in trying to encourage more rapid development.

- 1. Adopting policies that successfully promote development
- 2. Finding money to pay for development

How do they do it?

LDCs choose between two models:

- 1. One emphasizes self sufficiency
- 2. The other emphasizes international trade

Development Through Self-Sufficiency

What are the advantages of using self-sufficiency for development? What are the problems with using the self-sufficiency approach?

<u>Development Through International Trade</u>

Through this model of development, a country identifies its unique economic asset, whatever it may be, and then gets other countries to buy it. This brings capital (money) into the country who then uses it for developing their country.
