

How to use possessive adjectives in a complete Spanish sentence.

Step 1:

What is the noun

El cepillo

Step 2:




Refer to your chart

Yo	Nosotros /Nosotras	mío /mía míos /mías	nuestro /nuestra nuestros/ nuestras
(Tú)		tuyo / tuya tuyos /tuyas	
(Usted) (Él) (Ella)	(Ustedes) (Ellos) (Ellas)	suyo / suya suyos /suyas	suyo / suya suyos /suyas

El cepillo

Step 3: Who's is it?

Let's say
"Nosotros,-a"



Yo	Nosotros /Nosotras	mío /mía míos /mías	nuestro /nuestra nuestros/ nuestras
(Tú)		tuyo / tuya tuyos /tuyas	
(Usted) (Él) (Ella)	(Ustedes) (Ellos) (Ellas)	suyo / suya suyos /suyas	suyo / suya suyos /suyas

El cepillo

So, you know, it will have to be one of the options/words in the box.

Step 4: Now match in gender and number with the noun

Let's say
"Nosotros,-a"


Yo	Nosotros /Nosotras	mío /mía míos /mías	nuestro /nuestra nuestros/ nuestras
(Tú)		tuyo / tuya tuyos /tuyas	
(Usted) (Él) (Ella)	(Ustedes) (Ellos) (Ellas)	suyo / suya suyos /suyas	suyo / suya suyos /suyas

El cepillo **nuestro**

Now match the noun with correct gender and number. "El cepillo" is masculine and singular, so we match with "Nuestro" because it is the only one in the group that is masculine and singular.

Step 5:
Add “es” or “son”
At the beginning

Let’s say
“Nosotros,-a”

Yo	Nosotros /Nosotras	mío /mía míos /mías	nuestro /nuestra nuestros/ nuestras
(Tú)		tuyo / tuya tuyos /tuyas	
(Usted) (Él) (Ella)	(Ustedes) (Ellos) (Ellas)	suyo / suya suyos /suyas	suyo / suya suyos /suyas

Es el cepillo **nuestro**

Use “**Es**” or “**Son**” at the beginning of the sentence.

Recall that “**Es**” is for singular items or things.

Recall that “**Son**” is for plural items or things.

In this case, “el cepillo” is singular so we use “es”
